- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 39.33.010 and 1981 c 96 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
 - (1) The state or any municipality or any political subdivision thereof, may sell, transfer, exchange, lease or otherwise dispose of any property, real or personal, or property rights, including but not limited to the title to real property, to the state or any municipality or any political subdivision thereof, ((or)) the federal government, or a foreign entity, on such terms and conditions as may be mutually agreed upon by the proper authorities of the state and/or the subdivisions concerned.
 - (2) This section shall be deemed to provide an alternative method for the doing of the things authorized herein, and shall not be construed as imposing any additional condition upon the exercise of any other powers vested in the state, municipalities or political subdivisions.

- 1 (3) No intergovernmental transfer, lease, or other disposition of 2 property made pursuant to any other provision of law prior to May 23, 3 1972, shall be construed to be invalid solely because the parties 4 thereto did not comply with the procedures of this section.
 - <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect immediately.
