1 AN ACT Relating to public facilities districts; and amending RCW
2 36.100.030.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 36.100.030 and 1999 c 165 s 16 are each amended to
5 read as follows:

6 (1) A public facilities district is authorized to acquire,
7 construct, own, remodel, maintain, equip, reequip, repair, and operate
8 sports and recreation facilities, entertainment facilities, convention
9 facilities, or regional centers as defined in RCW 35.57.020, together
10 with contiguous parking facilities. The taxes that are provided for in
11 this chapter may only be imposed for these purposes.

12 (2) A public facilities district may enter into agreements under
13 chapter 39.34 RCW for the joint provision and operation of such
14 facilities and may enter into contracts under chapter 39.34 RCW where
15 any party to the contract provides and operates such facilities for the
16 other party or parties to the contract.

17 (3) Notwithstanding the establishment of a career, civil, or merit
18 service system, a public (~~(facility [facilities])~~) facilities district

1 may contract with a public or private entity for the operation or
2 management of its public facilities.

3 (4) A public facilities district is authorized to use the
4 supplemental alternative public works contracting procedures set forth
5 in chapter 39.10 RCW in connection with the design, construction,
6 reconstruction, remodel, or alteration of any of its public facilities.

7 (5) A public facilities district may impose charges and fees for
8 the use of its facilities, and may accept and expend or use gifts,
9 grants, and donations.
