1 AN ACT Relating to recognizing concealed weapon licenses issued by
2 other states; and adding a new section to chapter 9.41 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 9.41 RCW
5 to read as follows:

6 (1) A person licensed to carry a handgun in any state the laws of
7 which recognize and give effect in that state to a concealed pistol
8 license issued under the laws of the state of Washington is authorized
9 to carry a pistol in this state. This section applies to a license
10 holder from another state only while the license holder is not a
11 resident of this state. A license holder from another state must carry
12 the handgun in compliance with the laws of this state.

13 (2) The attorney general shall periodically publish a list of
14 states the laws of which recognize and give effect in that state to a
15 concealed pistol license issued under the laws of the state of
16 Washington.
