- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- MEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 70.02 RCW to read as follows:
- 6 (1) The accuracy of a patient's medical records is of great 7 importance. Under no circumstance shall any health care provider, 8 health care facility, or health carrier alter, distort, change, or 9 otherwise revise the original reporting of the patient's diagnosis, 10 treatment, condition, or prognosis, or the record containing such
- documentation except to expand or broaden the accuracy of the record
- 12 content.
- 13 (2) Amendments, corrections, clarifications, or completions to a 14 medical record must be dated and identified as such.
- 15 (3) The author of the original record or the author of any change 16 in a record shall be identified. The patient shall be notified of any 17 change to the record.
