1 AN ACT Relating to designation of highways of statewide
2 significance; and amending RCW 47.05.022.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 47.05.022 and 2002 c 56 s 302 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 (~~The legislature designates~~) The following highways are of
7 statewide significance:

8 (1) That portion of state route number 509 that runs or will run
9 from state route number 518 in the north to the intersection with
10 Interstate 5 in the south ((as a state highway of statewide
11 significance));

12 (2) That portion of state route number 6 that runs from a junction
13 with state route number 101 at Raymond, thence easterly by way of Lebam
14 and Pe Ell to a junction with state route number 5 at Chehalis.
