- AN ACT Relating to "work activity" for purposes of the temporary
- 2 assistance for needy families program; and amending RCW 74.08A.250.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 74.08A.250 and 2000 c 10 s 1 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- 6 Unless the context clearly requires otherwise, as used in this 7 chapter, "work activity" means:
  - (1) Unsubsidized paid employment in the private or public sector;
- 9 (2) Subsidized paid employment in the private or public sector((7 including));
- 11 (3) Employment through the state or federal work-study program and
- 12 <u>the accompanying education program</u> for a period not to exceed twenty-
- 13 four months. Students who work the maximum state or federal work-study
- 14 offered to them by their educational institution while attending the
- 15 <u>accompanying education program shall be considered full-time WorkFirst</u>
- 16 participants;

- 18 (a) An internship or practicum, that is paid or unpaid and is 19 required to complete a course of vocational training or to obtain a

- license or certificate in a high demand field, as determined by the employment security department. No internship or practicum shall exceed twelve months; or
- 4 (b) Work associated with the refurbishing of publicly assisted bousing, if sufficient paid employment is not available;

- 7 (((5))) <u>(6)</u> Job search and job readiness assistance;
- 8  $((\frac{6}{}))$  Community service programs;
- 9  $((\frac{7}{}))$  (8) Vocational educational training, not to exceed twelve months with respect to any individual;
- 11  $((\frac{8}{}))$  Job skills training directly related to employment;
- 12 (((+9))) (10) Education directly related to employment, in the case of a recipient who has not received a high school diploma or a GED;
  - (((10))) (11) Satisfactory attendance at secondary school or in a course of study leading to a GED, in the case of a recipient who has not completed secondary school or received such a certificate;

  - ((<del>(13)</del>)) <u>(14)</u> Practicums, which include any educational program in which a student is working under the close supervision of a professional in an agency, clinic, or other professional practice setting for purposes of advancing their skills and knowledge; and
- 26  $((\frac{14}{14}))$  (15) Services required by the recipient under RCW 74.08.025(3) and 74.08A.010(3) to become employable.
