- 1 AN ACT Relating to monetary offerings for revenue enhancement;
- 2 adding a new section to chapter 43.79 RCW; creating a new section; and
- 3 declaring an emergency.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** The legislature finds that the state's
- 6 current tax structure does not meet the needs perceived by some
- 7 citizens of the state to contribute a sufficient amount of their
- 8 personal resources to the support of state programs and services. The
- 9 legislature therefore declares that it is the responsibility of state
- 10 government to create an opportunity for such citizens to provide
- 11 enhancements to state revenues in a way that ensures recognition of
- 12 their generosity and civic-mindedness.
- 13 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 43.79 RCW
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 The monetary offerings for revenue enhancement account, which may
- 16 be known and cited as the MORE account, is created in the state
- 17 treasury. All receipts from citizens' voluntary contributions,
- 18 donations, gifts, bequests, grants, or other sources granted or given

- 1 for this account shall be deposited in the MORE account. Money in the
- 2 MORE account may be spent only after appropriation. Expenditures from
- 3 the MORE account may be used for the support of any function currently
- 4 supported by the general fund.
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 6 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 7 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect
- 8 immediately.
