10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

11 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** The legislature recognizes the great
12 sacrifices that residents of this state may make through military
13 service. The legislature also recognizes that out-of-state military
14 service might prevent a person from renewing a state-required license
15 in a timely manner. Persons serving their country in the military
16 should not be penalized in this manner for such service. It is the
17 intent of the legislature that persons who, because of military service
18 outside of this state, are unable to renew various licenses in a timely
19 manner, should be allowed to renew those licenses without incurring
20 monetary penalties that may ordinarily apply to the late renewal of a
21 license. It is the intent of the legislature that, under such
22 circumstances, each state agency or entity, and each local government
23 entity, be directed to renew any state-required licenses that are
24 issued or may be issued by the state or local entity. It is not the
25 intent of the legislature that any such renewal be allowed for a person
26 who is not at the time of the renewal fully qualified for the license
27 in question.

28 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 43.24 RCW
29 to read as follows:

30 (1) To the extent that the department of licensing has authority to
31 issue a license that must or may be renewed by the license holder, the
32 department of licensing shall issue a license renewal to a person who
33 is a member of the armed forces, including the national guard and armed
34 forces reserves, if the person was unable to renew his or her license
35 because of the person's assignment, reassignment, or deployment for

1 out-of-state military service. Such a person may renew his or her
2 license within ninety days after the person returns to this state from
3 out-of-state military service if the person's out-of-state military
4 service was honorable, and if the person provides the following to the
5 issuing authority no later than ninety days after the person's date of
6 discharge or assignment, reassignment, or deployment back to this
7 state: (a) A copy of the person's original order designating the
8 specific period of assignment, reassignment, or deployment for out-of-
9 state military service, and (b) if applicable, a copy of the person's
10 discharge or amended or subsequent assignment, reassignment, or
11 deployment order back to this state. A license so renewed under this
12 section shall take effect on the expiration date of the prior license.
13 A licensee renewing under this section shall pay only the applicable
14 renewal fee for the license and shall not be required to pay a penalty
15 or fee for late renewal.

16 (2) For the purposes of this section, "license" means a franchise,
17 permit, certification, approval, registration, charter, or similar form
18 of authorization required by state law.

19 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 43.70 RCW
20 to read as follows:

21 (1) To the extent that the secretary of health has authority to
22 issue a license that must or may be renewed by the license holder, the
23 secretary of health shall issue a license renewal to a person who is a
24 member of the armed forces, including the national guard and armed
25 forces reserves, if the person was unable to renew his or her license
26 because of the person's assignment, reassignment, or deployment for
27 out-of-state military service. Such a person may renew his or her
28 license within ninety days after the person returns to this state from
29 out-of-state military service if the person's out-of-state military
30 service was honorable, and if the person provides the following to the
31 issuing authority no later than ninety days after the person's date of
32 discharge or assignment, reassignment, or deployment back to this
33 state: (a) A copy of the person's original order designating the
34 specific period of assignment, reassignment, or deployment for out-of-
35 state military service, and (b) if applicable, a copy of the person's
36 discharge or amended or subsequent assignment, reassignment, or
37 deployment order back to this state. A license so renewed under this

15 armed forces reserves, if the person was unable to renew his or her
16 license because of the person's assignment, reassignment, or deployment
17 for out-of-state military service. Such a person may renew his or her
18 license within ninety days after the person returns to this state from
19 out-of-state military service if the person's out-of-state military
20 service was honorable, and if the person provides the following to the
21 issuing authority no later than ninety days after the person's date of
22 discharge or assignment, reassignment, or deployment back to this

5 to a person who is a member of the armed forces, including the national
6 guard and armed forces reserves, if the person was unable to renew his
7 or her license because of the person's assignment, reassignment, or
8 deployment for out-of-state military service. Such a person may renew
9 his or her license within ninety days after the person returns to this
10 state from out-of-state military service if the person's out-of-state
11 military service was honorable, and if the person provides the
12 following to the issuing authority no later than ninety days after the
13 person's date of discharge or assignment, reassignment, or deployment
14 back to this state: (a) A copy of the person's original order
15 designating the specific period of assignment, reassignment, or
16 deployment for out-of-state military service, and (b) if applicable, a
