1            AN ACT Relating to off-campus disruptive behavior of higher  
2 education students; and adding a new section to chapter 28B.10 RCW.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4            NEW SECTION.    **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 28B.10 RCW  
5 to read as follows:

6            The governing board of each institution of higher education is  
7 authorized to adopt a student code of conduct that applies while  
8 students are on campus and in campus neighborhoods, businesses, and  
9 public places that are proximate to the campus of the institution. The  
10 provisions in the code may not violate the civil rights of students as  
11 protected by the Constitution of the United States or the state of  
12 Washington. The code must provide due process procedures and rights  
13 for students who have been accused of misconduct. The governing board  
14 may adopt the code only after consultation with student  
15 representatives.
