- 1 AN ACT Relating to the unlawful use of a hook; adding a new section
- 2 to chapter 77.15 RCW; prescribing penalties; and declaring an
- 3 emergency.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 77.15 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (1) A person is guilty of the unlawful use of a hook if the person 8 intentionally utilizes, or attempts to use, a metallic hook in such a 9 way that it could be reasonably foreseen to pierce the flesh or mouth
- 10 of a bird or terrestrial mammal.
- 11 (2) Unlawful use of a hook is a gross misdemeanor.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** This act is necessary for the immediate
- 13 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
- 14 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect
- 15 immediately.
