- AN ACT Relating to providing public notices of public health, safety, and welfare in a language other than English; and adding a new

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 1.20 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (1) State agencies shall provide public notices, whether required 8 by law or rule, in a language other than English if a significant segment of the affected community or area is of limited English 9 proficiency and speaks a language other than English. This requirement 10 is only for notices that involve a public health, safety, or welfare 11 12 including, but not limited to, proposed locations 13 facilities that would house sex offenders, or proposed locations for criminal facilities. 14
- 15 (2) "Significant segment," for purposes of this section, means five 16 percent or more of the citizens living in the affected community or 17 area who speak a language other than English, or ten thousand or more
