- AN ACT Relating to establishing the orca whale as the state mammal;
- 2 adding a new section to chapter 1.20 RCW; and creating a new section.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that many people visit 5 Washington state to watch orca whales, the orca whale is a significant symbol for the Native American culture, there are pods of orca whales 6 7 that migrate annually through Puget Sound, and the orca whale is easily 8 recognizable because of its distinct markings. The legislature intends 9 to promote orca whale awareness and to encourage protection of the 10 natural marine habitat by designating the orca whale as the official 11 mammal of the state of Washington.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 1.20 RCW to read as follows:
- The orca whale, *orcinus orca*, is hereby designated as the official mammal of the state of Washington.
