- 1 AN ACT Relating to determining eligibility for veteran's regular or
- 2 special license plates; and amending RCW 73.04.110.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 73.04.110 and 1987 c 98 s 2 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
- Any person who is a veteran as defined in RCW ((41.04.005))
- 7 41.04.007 who submits to the department of licensing satisfactory proof
- 8 of a service-connected disability rating from the veterans
- 9 administration or the military service from which the veteran was
- 10 discharged and:
- 11 (1) Has lost the use of both hands or one foot;
- 12 (2) Was captured and incarcerated for more than twenty-nine days by
- 13 an enemy of the United States during a period of war with the United
- 14 States;
- 15 (3) Has become blind in both eyes as the result of military
- 16 service; or
- 17 (4) Is rated by the veterans administration or the military service
- 18 from which the veteran was discharged and is receiving service-

- 1 connected compensation at the one hundred percent rate that is expected
- 2 to exist for more than one year;
- 3 is entitled to regular or special license plates issued by the
- 4 department of licensing. The special license plates shall bear
- 5 distinguishing marks, letters, or numerals indicating that the motor
- 6 vehicle is owned by a disabled veteran or former prisoner of war. This
- 7 license shall be issued annually for one personal use vehicle without
- 8 payment of any license fees or excise tax thereon. Whenever any person
- 9 who has been issued license plates under the provisions of this section
- 10 applies to the department for transfer of the plates to a subsequently
- 11 acquired motor vehicle, a transfer fee of five dollars shall be charged
- 12 in addition to all other appropriate fees. The department may
- 13 periodically verify the one hundred percent rate as provided in
- 14 subsection (4) of this section.
- Any person who has been issued free motor vehicle license plates
- 16 under this section prior to July 1, 1983, shall continue to be eligible
- 17 for the annual free license plates.
- 18 For the purposes of this section, "blind" means the definition of
- 19 "blind" used by the state of Washington in determining eligibility for
- 20 financial assistance to the blind under Title 74 RCW.
- 21 Any unauthorized use of a special plate is a gross misdemeanor.
