NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. A new section is added to chapter 41.05 RCW to read as follows:

All state-purchased health care that provides coverage for prostheses must include coverage for hearing aids and cochlear implants if the patient's physician or advanced registered nurse practitioner as authorized by the nursing care quality assurance commission under chapter 18.79 RCW or physician assistant under chapter 18.71A RCW recommends the hearing aid or cochlear implant.

This section does not prevent the application of standard health plan provisions applicable to other benefits such as deductible or copayment provisions or limit the authority of the state health care authority to negotiate rates and contract with specific providers for

A group insurance contract or blanket disability insurance contract that provides coverage for prostheses must include coverage for hearing aids and cochlear implants if the patient's physician or advanced registered nurse practitioner as authorized by the nursing care quality assurance commission under chapter 18.79 RCW or physician assistant under chapter 18.71A RCW recommends the hearing aid or cochlear implant.
