- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- Sec. 1. The legislature finds that passenger-only 4 NEW SECTION. 5 ferry service is an important component in the overall transportation system. Conclusions drawn by the 2000 Joint Task Force 6 7 on Ferries include the recommendation that the state should continue to 8 provide and maintain both auto ferry and passenger-only ferry service and that the Washington State Ferries is the most cost-effective 9 10 provider of passenger-only service provided at that time. The legislature further finds that in order to allow options for the 11
- 12 traveling public, state-sponsored passenger-only service must continue
- 13 to be provided and expanded where practical.
- 14 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 47.60 RCW
- 15 to read as follows:
