- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 26.26.330 and 2002 c 302 s 307 are each amended to read as follows:
- A signatory may rescind an acknowledgment or denial of paternity by commencing a court proceeding to rescind before the earlier of:
 - (1) Sixty days after the effective date ((of the filing)) of the acknowledgment or denial, as provided in RCW 26.26.315; or
- 10 (2) The date of the first hearing in a proceeding to which the 11 signatory is a party before a court to adjudicate an issue relating to 12 the child, including a proceeding that establishes support.
- 13 **Sec. 2.** RCW 26.26.310 and 2002 c 302 s 303 are each amended to 14 read as follows:
- 15 A presumed father of a child may sign a denial of his paternity.
- 16 The denial is valid only if:
- 17 (1) An acknowledgment of paternity signed by another man is filed under RCW 26.26.320;

3	(3) The presumed father has not previously:
