1 AN ACT Relating to the governor's signature on significant  
2 legislative rules; and amending RCW 34.05.360.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 34.05.360 and 1988 c 288 s 311 are each amended to  
5 read as follows:

6 The order of adoption by which each rule is adopted by an agency  
7 shall contain all of the following:

8 (1) The date the agency adopted the rule;

9 (2) A concise statement of the purpose of the rule;

10 (3) A reference to all rules repealed, amended, or suspended by the  
11 rule;

12 (4) A reference to the specific statutory or other authority  
13 authorizing adoption of the rule;

14 (5) Any findings required by any provision of law as a precondition  
15 to adoption or effectiveness of the rule; (~~and~~)

16 (6) If the rule qualifies as a significant legislative rule of an  
17 agency that is under the authority of the governor, the signature of  
18 the governor; and

1        (7) The effective date of the rule if other than that specified in  
2        RCW 34.05.380(2).

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
