1 AN ACT Relating to making an irrevocable choice to waive rights to
2 the defined benefit under the plan 3 retirement systems; adding a new
3 section to chapter 41.32 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 41.35
4 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 41.40 RCW; and declaring an
5 emergency.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

7 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 41.32 RCW
8 to read as follows:

9 Any member receiving or having received a distribution under
10 chapter 41.34 RCW may make an irrevocable choice to waive all rights to
11 a benefit under RCW 41.32.840 by notifying the department in writing of
12 their intention.

13 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 41.35 RCW
14 to read as follows:

15 Any member receiving or having received a distribution under
16 chapter 41.34 RCW may make an irrevocable choice to waive all rights to
17 a benefit under RCW 41.35.620 by notifying the department in writing of
18 their intention.

1 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 41.40 RCW
2 to read as follows:

3 Any member receiving or having received a distribution under
4 chapter 41.34 RCW may make an irrevocable choice to waive all rights to
5 a benefit under RCW 41.40.790 by notifying the department in writing of
6 their intention.

7 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 4.** This act is necessary for the immediate
8 preservation of the public peace, health, or safety, or support of the
9 state government and its existing public institutions, and takes effect
10 immediately.
