- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 46.16 RCW 6 to read as follows:
 - (1) Applications for annual license tab fees, gross weight fees, and additional fees for recreational vehicles, as authorized in this chapter, must permit applicants to voluntarily contribute funds in whole dollar increments to assist persons with special transportation needs. The department shall provide a space on the application for the contributions. Proceeds will be remitted to the custody of the state treasurer with a proper identifying detailed report. The state treasurer shall credit the funds to the special needs transportation account created in section 2 of this act. Funds must be expended as provided in section 2 of this act.
- 17 (2) The department shall discontinue the voluntary contribution and 18 distribution of associated proceeds if the agency council on 19 coordinated transportation established in chapter 47.06B RCW no longer
