## SUBSTITUTE SENATE BILL 5121

- 1 AN ACT Relating to high-occupancy vehicle lanes; amending RCW
- 2 46.61.165, 47.52.025, and 81.100.020; adding a new section to chapter
- 3 46.61 RCW; adding a new section to chapter 47.52 RCW; and adding new
- 4 sections to chapter 43.131 RCW.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 **Sec. 1.** RCW 46.61.165 and 1999 c 206 s 1 are each amended to read 7 as follows:
- 8 (1) The state department of transportation and the local
- 9 authorities are authorized to reserve all or any portion of any highway
- 10 under their respective jurisdictions, including any designated lane or
- 11 ramp, for the exclusive or preferential use of the following vehicles
- 12 when the limitation will increase the efficient use of the highway
- 13 <u>facility or will aid in the conservation of energy resources: (a)</u>
- 14 <u>Public</u> transportation vehicles ((<del>or</del>)); (b) private motor vehicles 15 carrying no fewer than a specified number of passengers ((<del>when such</del>
- 16 limitation will increase the efficient utilization of the highway or
- 17 will aid in the conservation of energy resources)); or (c) motorcycles.
- 18 <u>(2)</u> Regulations authorizing such exclusive or preferential use of
- 19 a highway facility may be declared to be effective at all times or at

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- specified times of day or on specified days. Violation of a restriction of highway usage prescribed by the appropriate authority
- 3 under this section is a traffic infraction.
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 46.61 RCW 5 to read as follows:
  - (1) Under RCW 46.61.165 and 47.52.025, exclusive use of freeway high-occupancy vehicle lanes must be restricted solely to the hours of 6:00 a.m. through 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. through 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, excluding state holidays, on the following facilities:
- 10 (a) Interstate 405;

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- 11 (b) State route number 167;
- 12 (c) Interstate 90 east of Interstate 405;
- 13 (d) State route number 520 east of Interstate 405.
- 14 (2) The following facilities are exempt from this section:
- 15 (a) High-occupancy direct access ramps;
  - (b) High-occupancy vehicle freeway queue bypasses; and
- 17 (c) High-occupancy vehicle ramp meter bypasses.
- 18 **Sec. 3.** RCW 47.52.025 and 1974 ex.s. c 133 s 1 are each amended to 19 read as follows:
- 20 (1) Highway authorities of the state, counties, and incorporated cities and towns, in addition to the specific powers granted in this 21 22 chapter, shall also have, and may exercise, relative to limited access 23 facilities, any and all additional authority, now or hereafter vested 24 in them relative to highways or streets within their respective 25 jurisdictions, and may regulate, restrict, or prohibit the use of such limited access facilities by various classes of vehicles or traffic. 26 Such highway authorities may reserve any limited access facility or 27 portions thereof, including designated lanes or ramps for the exclusive 28 or preferential use of the following vehicles when the limitation will 29 increase the efficient use of the highway facility or will aid in the 30 <u>conservation</u> of <u>energy resources</u>: (a) <u>Public transportation</u> 31 vehicles((, privately owned buses, or)); (b) private motor vehicles 32 carrying not less than a specified number of passengers ((when such 33 34 limitation will increase the efficient utilization of the highway 35 facility or will aid in the conservation of energy resources)); or (c) 36 motorcycles.

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- 1 (2) Regulations authorizing such exclusive or preferential use of 2 a highway facility may be declared to be effective at all time or at 3 specified times of day or on specified days.
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 4.** A new section is added to chapter 47.52 RCW 5 to read as follows:
  - (1) Under RCW 46.61.165 and 47.52.025, exclusive use of freeway high-occupancy vehicle lanes must be restricted solely to the hours of 6:00 a.m. through 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. through 6:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, excluding state holidays, on the following facilities:
- 10 (a) Interstate 405;

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- 11 (b) State route number 167;
- 12 (c) Interstate 90 east of Interstate 405;
- 13 (d) State route number 520 east of Interstate 405.
- 14 (2) The following facilities are exempt from this section:
- 15 (a) High-occupancy direct access ramps;
- 16 (b) High-occupancy vehicle freeway queue bypasses; and
- 17 (c) High-occupancy vehicle ramp meter bypasses.
- 18 **Sec. 5.** RCW 81.100.020 and 1990 c 43 s 13 are each amended to read 19 as follows:
- 20 Unless the context clearly requires otherwise, the definitions in 21 this section apply throughout this chapter.
  - (1) "Transit agency" means a city that operates a transit system, a public transportation benefit area, a county transportation authority, or a metropolitan municipal corporation.
  - (2) The "high\_occupancy vehicle system" includes high\_occupancy vehicle lanes, related high\_occupancy vehicle facilities, and high\_occupancy vehicle programs.
  - (3) "High\_occupancy vehicle lanes" mean lanes reserved for public transportation vehicles only or public transportation vehicles and private vehicles carrying no fewer than a specified number of passengers under RCW 46.61.165 and 47.52.025.
- 32 (4) "Related facilities" means park and ride lots, park and pool 33 lots, ramps, bypasses, turnouts, signal preemption, and other 34 improvements designed to maximize use of the high\_occupancy vehicle 35 system.

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- 1 (5) "High\_occupancy vehicle program" means advertising the high\_
  2 occupancy vehicle system, promoting carpool, vanpool, and transit use,
  3 providing vanpool vehicles, and enforcement of driving restrictions
  4 governing high\_occupancy vehicle lanes.
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 6.** A new section is added to chapter 43.131 RCW 6 to read as follows:
- Sections 2 and 4 of this act must be reviewed under this chapter before June 30, 2008. The department of transportation shall provide the information necessary for the joint legislative audit and review committee to provide the required review.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 7. A new section is added to chapter 43.131 RCW to read as follows:
- The following acts or parts of acts as now existing or hereafter amended, are each repealed, effective June 30, 2009:
  - (1) Section 2 of this act; and
- 16 (2) Section 4 of this act.

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
