- AN ACT Relating to geoducks; amending RCW 79.96.085; and adding new
- 2 sections to chapter 79.96 RCW.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 79.96 RCW 5 to read as follows:
- 6 The state and federally recognized Indian tribes must provide the
- 7 labor and equipment necessary to reseed publicly owned aquatic lands
- 8 after a geoduck harvest.
- 9 Sec. 2. RCW 79.96.085 and 1990 c 163 s 5 are each amended to read
- 10 as follows:
- 11 (1) The department of natural resources shall designate the areas
- 12 of aquatic lands owned by the state that are available for geoduck
- 13 harvesting by licensed geoduck harvesters in accordance with chapter
- 14 79.90 RCW.
- 15 (2) The department of natural resources must offer to lease to
- 16 private parties aquatic lands that have already been harvested of
- 17 geoducks for the purpose of allowing private parties to reseed and
- 18 culture geoducks.

- 1 (3) A free-floating geoduck is the property of the landowner on whose property the geoduck alights.
- 3 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 3.** A new section is added to chapter 79.96 RCW 4 to read as follows:
- 5 The department of natural resources shall lease aquatic lands 6 beyond seventy feet mean low water (0.0. ft.) for geoduck harvesting.
