- AN ACT Relating to human cloning; adding a new chapter to Title 70
- 2 RCW; and prescribing penalties.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- MEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The definitions in this section apply throughout this chapter unless the context clearly requires otherwise.
- (1) "Cloning of a human being" means asexual reproduction by implanting or attempting to implant the product of nuclear transplantation into a uterus or substitute for a uterus with the purpose of producing a human being.
- 10 (2) "Nuclear transplantation" means transferring the nucleus of a 11 human somatic cell into an oocyte from which the nucleus has been or 12 will be removed or inactivated.
- 13 (3) "Human somatic cell" means a diploid cell that is obtained or 14 derived from a living or deceased human at any stage of development.
- 15 (4) "Oocyte" means the unfertilized human ovum.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. (1) No person may knowingly engage or assist in the cloning or attempted cloning of a human being.

1 (2) The attorney general may bring an action to enjoin any person 2 from violating subsection (1) of this section.

- (3) Any person who violates subsection (1) of this section is subject to a civil penalty not to exceed one hundred thousand dollars for each violation. Civil penalties authorized by this subsection may be imposed in any civil action brought by the attorney general.
- (4) Nothing in this section shall be construed to restrict areas of biomedical, agricultural, and scientific research not specifically prohibited by this section.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. Sections 1 and 2 of this act constitute a new chapter in Title 70 RCW.
