- 1 AN ACT Relating to the taxation of direct mail; adding a new 2 section to chapter 82.12 RCW; and providing an effective date.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- MEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 82.12 RCW to read as follows:
 - The provisions of this chapter shall not apply in respect to the use of a mailer, and the postage directly incurred with delivering such a mailer, if the mailer is both printed outside the state and mailed directly from outside the state to a mass audience.
- For the purposes of this section, a "mailer" consists solely of unbound sheets of paper in a mailing envelope, the primary purpose of which mailer is to promote the sale of products or services for more than one business and the businesses are unrelated to the person creating and printing the mailer. The exemption in this section does not extend to promotional material included with billing statements or statements of account.
