- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 47.68.240 and 2000 c 229 s 2 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
 - (1) Any person violating any of the provisions of this chapter, or any of the rules, regulations, or orders issued pursuant thereto, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be punished as provided under chapter 9A.20 RCW, except that any person violating any of the provisions of RCW 47.68.220, 47.68.230, or 47.68.255 shall be guilty of a gross misdemeanor which shall be punished as provided under chapter 9A.20 RCW. In addition to, or in lieu of, the penalties provided in this section, or as a condition to the suspension of a sentence which may be imposed pursuant thereto, for violations of RCW 47.68.220 and 47.68.230, the court in its discretion may prohibit the violator from operating an aircraft within the state for such period as it may determine but not to exceed one year. Violation of the duly imposed prohibition of the court may be treated as a separate offense under

- (b) For the third and subsequent violations, a civil penalty of four hundred dollars per aircraft.

 12 required by this chapter, is subject to a civil penalty of four times
 13 the fees that are due.
- 14 (4) The revenue from penalties prescribed in subsection (2) of this

 16 82.42.090. The revenue from penalties prescribed in subsection (3) of
 17 this section must be deposited into the aircraft search and rescue,
 18 safety, and education account under RCW 47.68.236.
