- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 7 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 48.20 RCW
- 8 to read as follows:
- 9 An insurer may not deny coverage for the treatment of an injury
- 10 solely because the injury was sustained as a consequence of the
- insured's being intoxicated or under the influence of a narcotic.
- 12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 2.** A new section is added to chapter 48.21 RCW
- 13 to read as follows:
- 14 An insurer may not deny coverage for the treatment of an injury
- 15 solely because the injury was sustained as a consequence of the
- insured's being intoxicated or under the influence of a narcotic.

- NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. A new section is added to chapter 48.44 RCW to read as follows:
- A health care service contractor may not deny coverage for the treatment of an injury solely because the injury was sustained as a gargement of the annulled participant to being interigrated are under

- 6 the influence of a narcotic.

- 15 repealed.
- 16 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 6.** This act applies to all contracts issued or
- 17 renewed on or after the effective date of this act.
