- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 43.06.092 and 1981 c 338 s 2 are each amended to read 5 as follows:
 - (1) Any gubernatorial appointee subject to senate confirmation shall continue to serve only until rejected by a vote of the senate or until the conclusion of the second regularly scheduled legislative session after his or her appointment unless ((rejected)) confirmed by a vote of the senate. An appointee who is rejected by a vote of the senate shall not be reappointed to the same position for a period of one year from termination of service.
- 13 (2) Any person appointed by the governor to fill the unexpired term 14 of an appointment subject to senate confirmation must also be confirmed 15 by the senate.
