- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 7.70 RCW to read as follows:
- Figure 7 Every health care provider shall inform each patient, or an
- 8 individual identified pursuant to RCW 7.70.065(1), in person about
- 9 adverse incidents that result in serious harm to the patient.
- 10 Notification of outcomes of care that result in harm to the patient
- 11 under this section shall not constitute an acknowledgement or admission
- 12 of liability, nor can such notifications be introduced as evidence.
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 70.41 RCW
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 An appropriately trained person designated by each hospital shall
- 16 inform each patient, or an individual identified pursuant to RCW
- 17 7.70.065(1), in person about adverse incidents that result in serious
- 18 harm to the patient. Notification of outcomes of care that result in

- 1 harm to the patient under this section shall not constitute an
- 2 acknowledgement or admission of liability, nor can it be introduced as
- 3 evidence.
