## SENATE BILL 6218

- 1 AN ACT Relating to information on disciplinary actions taken
- 2 against school employees; adding a new section to chapter 28A.300 RCW;
- 3 and creating a new section.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 5 NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that it is in the best
- 6 interests of Washington's children that parents, school districts, and
- 7 the public in general have access to information regarding each school
- 8 employee's prior disciplinary action. The legislature recognizes that
- 9 this information is currently available via public disclosure requests
- 10 but finds that there is a need to make this information more easily
- 11 available. It is the intent of the legislature to provide parents,
- 12 school districts, and the public with additional tools to ensure a safe
- 13 learning environment for Washington's children.
- 14 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. A new section is added to chapter 28A.300
- 15 RCW to read as follows:
- 16 The superintendent of public instruction shall post on its web site
- 17 a list of school employees who have had any disciplinary action taken
- 18 against them and the grounds for the disciplinary action. The list

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shall be updated annually at a minimum and shall be available to the 1 2 public. For the purposes of this section, disciplinary action includes private or public reprimand, suspension, stayed suspension, 3 revocation of a license. A disciplinary action shall not be posted on 4 the web site if an appeal is still pending. A voluntary surrender of 5 a license or a voluntary termination of employment during an 6 investigation or a disciplinary action shall be posted on the web site 7 8 as such.

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
