- 6 **Sec. 1.** RCW 35.21.703 and 1985 c 92 s 1 are each amended to read 7 as follows:
- 8 It ((shall be)) is in the public purpose for, and all cities and
- 9 towns are authorized to, engage in economic development programs. To
- 10 carry out the programs, any city or town is authorized to transfer or
- 11 loan to any other city, town, county, or port district, with or without
- 12 consideration, any funds, real or personal property, property
- 13 <u>interests</u>, or <u>services</u>. In addition, cities <u>and towns</u> may contract
- 14 with ((nonprofit corporations)) public and private entities in
- 15 furtherance of this and other acts relating to economic development.
- 16 Sec. 2. RCW 36.01.085 and 1985 c 92 s 2 are each amended to read
- 17 as follows:
- 18 It ((shall be)) is in the public purpose for, and all counties are

- Any county may, upon the request of and pursuant to an interlocal
- 17 agreement with a port district, jointly exercise with that port
- 18 district any powers of the port district with respect to economic
- 19 development programs or projects.
- 20 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 5.** The powers granted by this act supplement
- 21 those previously authorized by law. Nothing in this act limits any
- 22 other authority of cities, towns, and counties. All prior actions
- 23 consistent with the provisions of this act are validated.
