1 AN ACT Relating to personal use shellfish licenses; and amending
2 RCW 77.32.520.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 77.32.520 and 2000 c 107 s 27 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 (1) A personal use shellfish and seaweed license or a razor clam
7 license is required for all persons other than residents or
8 nonresidents under (~~fifteen~~) eighteen years of age to fish for, take,
9 dig for, or possess seaweed or shellfish for personal use from state
10 waters or offshore waters including national park beaches. A razor
11 clam license allows a person to harvest razor clams only.

12 (2) The fees for annual personal use shellfish and seaweed licenses
13 are:

14 (a) For a resident (~~fifteen~~) eighteen years of age or older,
15 seven dollars;

16 (b) For a nonresident (~~fifteen~~) eighteen years of age or older,
17 twenty dollars; and

18 (c) For a senior, five dollars.

1 (3) The ((license)) fee for a ((two-day personal use shellfish and
2 ~~seaweed~~) razor clam license is six dollars for residents ((or)) and
3 fifteen dollars for nonresidents ((fifteen)) eighteen years of age or
4 older.

5 (4) The personal use shellfish and seaweed license or razor clam
6 license shall be visible on the licensee while harvesting shellfish or
7 seaweed.
