1 AN ACT Relating to exempting from taxation certain property
2 belonging to any federally recognized Indian tribe located in the
3 state; and amending RCW 84.36.010.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 84.36.010 and 1998 c 179 s 8 are each amended to read
6 as follows:

7 All property belonging exclusively to the United States, the state,
8 or any county or municipal corporation((~~7~~)); all property belonging
9 exclusively to any federally recognized Indian tribe located in the
10 state, if that property is used exclusively for essential government
11 services as defined in RCW 43.06.455; all state route number 16
12 corridor transportation systems and facilities constructed under
13 chapter 47.46 RCW((~~7~~)); and all property under a financing contract
14 pursuant to chapter 39.94 RCW or recorded agreement granting immediate
15 possession and use to ((~~said~~)) the public bodies listed in this section
16 or under an order of immediate possession and use pursuant to RCW
17 8.04.090((~~7~~,~~shall be~~)); is exempt from taxation. All property
18 belonging exclusively to a foreign national government ((~~shall be~~)) is
19 exempt from taxation if ((~~such~~)) that property is used exclusively as

1 an office or residence for a consul or other official representative of
2 ((~~such~~)) the foreign national government, and if the consul or other
3 official representative is a citizen of ((~~such~~)) that foreign nation.

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
