- AN ACT Relating to assumption by a code city with a population greater than one hundred thousand of a water-sewer district with fewer than two hundred fifty customers; adding a new section to chapter 35.13A RCW; and providing an expiration date.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 6 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 35.13A RCW to read as follows:
- (1) The board of commissioners of a water-sewer district, with 8 9 fewer than two hundred fifty customers on the effective date of this 10 act, and the city council of a code city with a population greater than one hundred thousand on the effective date of this act, may provide for 11 assumption by the city of the district in accordance with RCW 12 13 35.13A.020, except as provided herein, pursuant to the terms and conditions of a contract executed in accordance with RCW 35.13A.070. 14 15 None of the territory of the water-sewer district need be included within the territory of the city. The contract and assumption shall be 16 approved by resolution of the board of commissioners and ordinance of 17 the city council. If the water-sewer district has no indebtedness or 18 19 monetary obligations on the date of assumption, the city shall use any

surplus funds only for water services delivered to and water facilities constructed in the former territory of the district, unless provided otherwise in the contract. In connection with the assumption, the water-sewer district or the city, or both, may provide for dissolution of the district pursuant to RCW 35.13A.080.

(2) This section expires December 31, 2006.
