1 AN ACT Relating to technical corrections to the requirements of
2 regional transportation investment district ballot measures; and
3 amending RCW 36.120.070.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

5 **Sec. 1.** RCW 36.120.070 and 2002 c 56 s 107 are each amended to
6 read as follows:

7 Two or more contiguous county legislative authorities, upon receipt
8 of the regional transportation investment plan under RCW 36.120.040,
9 may ~~((certify the plan to the ballot, including identification of the
10 tax options))~~ submit to the voters of the proposed district a single
11 ballot measure that approves formation of the district, approves the
12 regional transportation investment plan, and approves the revenue
13 sources necessary to ((fund)) finance the plan. ((County legislative
14 authorities)) The planning committee may draft ((a ballot title,)) the
15 ballot measure on behalf of the county legislative authorities, and the
16 county legislative authorities may give notice as required by law for
17 ballot measures, and perform other duties as required to ((put the plan
18 before)) submit the measure to the voters of the proposed district for
19 their approval or rejection ((as a single ballot measure that both

1 ~~approves formation of the district and approves the plan~~). Counties
2 may negotiate interlocal agreements necessary to implement the plan.
3 The electorate will be the voters voting within the boundaries of the
4 participating counties. A simple majority of the total persons voting
5 on the single ballot measure (~~to approve the plan, establish the~~
6 ~~district, and approve the taxes and fees~~) is required for approval of
7 the measure.
