1 AN ACT Relating to posting of hazards to motorcycles; amending RCW
2 47.36.200; creating a new section; and providing an effective date.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:

4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 47.36.200 and 1984 c 7 s 202 are each amended to read
5 as follows:

6 (1) When construction, repair, or maintenance work is conducted on
7 or adjacent to a public highway, county road, street, bridge, or other
8 thoroughfare commonly traveled and when the work interferes with the
9 normal and established mode of travel on the highway, county road,
10 street, bridge, or thoroughfare, the location shall be properly posted
11 by prominently displayed signs or flagmen or both. Signs used for
12 posting in such an area shall be consistent with the provisions found
13 in the state of Washington "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices
14 for Streets and Highways" obtainable from the department of
15 transportation.

16 (2) If the construction, repair, or maintenance work includes or
17 uses grooved pavement, abrupt lane edges, steel plates, or gravel or
18 earth surfaces, the construction, repair, or maintenance zone must be
19 posted with signs stating the condition, as required by current law,

1 and in addition, must warn motorcyclists of the potential hazard. For
2 the purposes of this subsection, the department shall adopt by rule a
3 uniform sign or signs for this purpose, including at least the
4 following language, "MOTORCYCLES USE EXTREME CAUTION."

5 NEW SECTION. Sec. 2. If specific funding for the purposes of this
6 act, referencing this act by bill or chapter number, is not provided by
7 June 30, 2003, in the omnibus transportation appropriations act, this
8 act is null and void.

9 NEW SECTION. Sec. 3. This act takes effect January 1, 2004.

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
