Brief Description: Phasing in audible pedestrian crossing signals.

HB 2590-S - DIGEST

(DIGEST OF PROPOSED 1ST SUBSTITUTE)

Requires the department to ensure that audible pedestrian crossing signals be installed at any location within the state where a project to be constructed meets the following conditions:
(1) The project scope includes the addition of pedestrian crossing signals;

(2) The project borders two or more general purpose local jurisdictions; and

(3) The inclusion of audible signals is consistent with local zoning and land use patterns and each local jurisdiction bordering the project requests the installation of the devices.
