HB 2736-S.E - DIGEST

(AS OF HOUSE 2ND READING 2/16/04)

Recognizes streamline the the need to governance transportation system in order to increase efficiency accountability to the people it serves. The legislature intends to create a single point of accountability for the performance of the state department of transportation by making management of the department directly accountable to the governor.

Proposes to further streamline governance structures. A bipartisan, bicameral review and analysis of the current duties and responsibilities of the transportation commission must be conducted to determine where these functions are best carried out.

Creates a bicameral, bipartisan review panel to conduct a review and analysis of the statutory duties, roles, functions, and responsibilities of the transportation commission. panel must make recommendations for the disposition of these roles, functions, and responsibilities, assuming duties, dissolved. transportation commission is making In recommendations, the review panel must, at a minimum, consider the proper separation of powers between the executive and legislative branches of government.

Directs the review panel to complete its analysis and forward its recommendations to the house of representatives and the senate by December 3, 2004.

Repeals RCW 47.01.051 and 47.01.071.
