Brief Description: Providing for rules concerning off-campus behavior of higher education students. Revised for 1st Substitute: Providing for regulating off-campus conduct.

HB 2807 - DIGEST

(SUBSTITUTED FOR - SEE 1ST SUB)

Requires each institution of higher education to adopt rules regarding disruptive off-campus conduct of students, including sanctions.

Provides that sanctions may include, but are not limited to, counseling, probation, suspension, or expulsion.

Declares that, as used in this act, "disruptive off-campus conduct" means any conduct that results in a citation or conviction for the violation of laws or ordinances and that: (1) Interferes with the institution of higher education's relationship with the surrounding community;

(2) Harms the reputation of the institution of higher education; or

(3) Violates the institution of higher education's policies.
