HB 1163-S by House Committee on Transportation (originally sponsored by Representative Murray; by request of Governor Locke)

Making 2001-03 and 2003-05 transportation appropriations.

(DIGEST OF PROPOSED 1ST SUBSTITUTE)

Makes 2003-05 transportation appropriations.

-- 2003 REGULAR SESSION --

Mar 28 TR - Majority; 1st substitute bill be substituted, do pass.

Minority; do not pass.

Apr 2 Placed on second reading.

Senate Bills

SB 5545-S by Senate Committee on Ways & Means (originally sponsored by Senators Esser, Reardon, Poulsen, Sheahan and Winsley; by request of Department of Health)

Using fees to develop and maintain a web-based vital records system.

(DIGEST OF PROPOSED 1ST SUBSTITUTE)

Uses fees for certified copies of vital records to develop and maintain a web-based vital records system.

Apr 2 WM - Majority; 1st substitute bill be substituted, do pass.

SB 6054-S by Senate Committee on Ways & Means (originally sponsored by Senators Rossi and Fairley; by request of Office of Financial Management)

Clarifying the application of the industrial welfare act to public employers.

(DIGEST OF PROPOSED 1ST SUBSTITUTE)

Finds that the enactment of chapter 236, Laws of 1988 amended the definition of employer under the industrial welfare act, chapter 49.12 RCW, to ensure that the family leave provisions of that act applied to the state and political subdivisions.

Finds that this amendment of the definition of employer may be interpreted as creating an ambiguity as to whether the other provisions of chapter 49.12 RCW apply to the state and political subdivisions. The purpose of this act is to make retroactive, remedial, and technical amendments to clarify the intent of chapter 236, Laws of 1988 and resolve any ambiguity.

Declares an intent to establish that, prior to the effective date of this act, chapter 49.12 RCW and the rules promulgated thereunder did not apply to the state or its

agencies and political subdivisions except as expressly provided for in RCW 49.12.270 through 49.12.295 and 49.12.450.

SB 6061 by Senators Horn, Haugen, Swecker, Spanel, Finkbeiner and Jacobsen

Authorizing transportation funding.

Authorizes transportation funding.

Apr 2 First reading, referred to Highways & Transportation.

SB 6062 by Senators Horn, Haugen, Swecker, Jacobsen, Finkbeiner and Spanel

Authorizing bonds for transportation funding.

Provides that, in order to provide funds necessary for the location, design, right of way, and construction of selected projects or improvements that are identified as transportation 2003 projects or improvements in the omnibus transportation budget, there shall be issued and sold upon the request of the transportation commission a total of two billion six hundred million dollars of general obligation bonds of the state of Washington.

Adjusting vehicle-related business fees.
