SB 5861-S.E - DIGEST

(DIGEST AS ENACTED)

Provides that a person is guilty of criminal impersonation in
the second degree if the person falsely assumes the identity of a
veteran or active duty member of the armed forces of the United
States with intent to defraud for the purpose of personal gain or
to facilitate any unlawful activity.
