SB 6560-S - DIGEST

(DIGEST AS ENACTED)

Provides that a person is guilty of the unlawful use of a hook if the person utilizes, or attempts to use, a hook with the intent to pierce the flesh or mouth of a bird or mammal.

Declares that unlawful use of a hook is a gross misdemeanor.
