EFFECT: Establishes that block grants for lead entities must be used to implement habitat project lists consistent with criteria established for the Salmon Recovery Funding Board. Directs lead entities and regional salmon recovery organizations to provide annual reports to the Salmon Recovery Funding Board summarizing the activities and outcomes accomplished with the block grant funding.
