The legislature also finds that 6 culturally relevant educational opportunities are important contributors to other efforts to increase the rates of high school 7 8 graduation for Native American students. The legislature further finds 9 that the higher education participation rate for Native American students is the lowest in the state, and that more can be done to 10 11 encourage Native American students to pursue higher educational 12 opportunities. The legislature intends to authorize accredited public 13 tribal colleges to participate in the running start program for the 14 purposes of reducing the dropout rate of Native American students and 15 encouraging greater participation rates in higher education.
