

**ESHB 2925 - S AMD 405**

**ADOPTED 3/8/2006**

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and insert the  
2 following:

3 "NEW SECTION. **Sec. 1.** A new section is added to chapter 74.39A  
4 RCW to read as follows:

5 (1) To the extent funds are appropriated for this purpose, the  
6 department shall establish a capital add-on rate, not less than the  
7 July 1, 2005, capital add-on rate established by the department, for  
8 those assisted living facilities contracting with the department that  
9 have a medicaid occupancy percentage of sixty percent or greater.

10 (2) Effective for July 1, 2006, and for each July 1st rate-setting  
11 period thereafter, the department shall determine the facility's  
12 medicaid occupancy percentage using the last six months' medicaid  
13 resident days from the preceding calendar year divided by the product  
14 of all its licensed boarding home beds irrespective of use, times  
15 calendar days for the six-month period. For the purposes of this  
16 section, medicaid resident days include those clients who are enrolled  
17 in a medicaid managed long-term care program, including but not limited  
18 to the program for all inclusive care and the medicaid integration  
19 project.

20 (3) The medicaid occupancy percentage established beginning on July  
21 1, 2006, and for each July 1st thereafter, shall be used to determine  
22 whether an assisted living facility qualifies for the capital add-on  
23 rate under this section. Those facilities that qualify for the capital  
24 add-on rate shall receive the capital add-on rate throughout the  
25 applicable fiscal year.

26 NEW SECTION. **Sec. 2.** This act takes effect July 1, 2006."

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4 On page 1, line 2 of the title, after "greater;" strike the  
5 remainder of the title and insert "adding a new section to chapter  
6 74.39A RCW; and providing an effective date."

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**EFFECT:** Provides for assisted living facilities with 60% or greater  
Medicaid occupancy to receive add-on rates effective July 1, 2006.
