1           On page 2, line 36, after "guidance." through "services." on page  
2 3, line 4 and insert "The medical advisory committee shall study and  
3 recommend strategies for adopting emerging technologies and best  
4 practices from the national, state, and local levels in the field of  
5 early prevention and detection for breast and cervical cancer and  
6 assist the early detection breast and cervical cancer screening program  
7 in implementing policy that follows the best practices of high quality  
8 health care for clinical, diagnostic, preventative, pathologic,  
9 radiological, and oncology services. The committee will report its  
10 recommendations to the Legislature no later than December 15, 2006."

11           Renumber the sections consecutively and correct any internal  
12 references accordingly.
