By Senators Roach, Stevens, Benson, Johnson, Esser, Carrell and Mulliken

1 Beginning on page 2, strike all of section 101 and insert the
2 following:

3 "Sec. 101. RCW 28A.305.010 and 1992 c 56 s 1 are each amended to
4 read as follows:

5 The state board of education shall be comprised of ((one)) :

6 (1)Two nonpartisan members from each congressional district of the
7 state, not including any congressional district at large, elected by
8 the ((members of the boards of directors of school districts thereof,
9 as hereinafter in this chapter provided, the superintendent of public
10 instruction and one member elected at large, as provided in this
11 chapter, by the members of the boards of directors of all private
12 schools in the state meeting the requirements of RCW 28A.195.010. The
13 member representing private schools shall not vote on matters affecting
14 public schools. If there is a dispute about whether or not an issue
15 directly affects public schools, the dispute shall be settled by a
16 majority vote of the other members of the board))voters of each
17 congressional district in the state; and

18 (2) One member elected at large by the members of the boards of
19 directors of all private schools in the state meeting the requirements
20 of RCW 28A.195.010. The member representing private schools shall not
21 vote on matters affecting public schools. If there is a dispute about
22 whether or not an issue directly affects public schools, the dispute
23 shall be settled by a majority vote of the other members of the board.
24 Not later than the twenty-fifth day of August of each year, the
25 superintendent of public instruction shall call for an election of the
26 member of the state board of education representing private schools if
27 the term of membership will end on the second Monday of the following
28 January. The superintendent of public instruction shall give written
29 notice thereof to the chair of the board of directors of each private
30 school who shall distribute the notice to each member of the private
31 school board. The notice shall include the election calendar and rules

1 established by the superintendent of public instruction for the conduct
2 of the election.

3 **Sec. 102.** RCW 28A.305.030 and 1992 c 56 s 3 are each amended to
4 read as follows:

5 (1) Whenever any new and additional congressional district is
6 created, except a congressional district at large, (~~the superintendent~~
7 ~~of public instruction shall call an election in such district at the~~
8 ~~time of making the call provided for in RCW 28A.305.020. Such election~~
9 ~~shall be conducted as other elections provided for in this chapter)) two
10 persons shall be elected at the next general election at which state
11 board of education members are elected to serve as members of the state
12 board of education. At the first such election one member of the state
13 board of education shall be elected for a term of four years.~~

14 (2) The terms of office of members of the state board of education
15 who are elected from the various congressional districts shall not be
16 affected by the creation of either new or new and additional districts.
17 In such an event, each board member may continue to serve in office for
18 the balance of the term for which he or she was elected or appointed:
19 PROVIDED, That the board member continues to reside within the
20 boundaries of the congressional district as they existed at the time of
21 his or her election or appointment. Vacancies (~~which~~) that occur in
22 a board member position during the balance of any such term shall be
23 filled (~~pursuant to RCW 28A.305.090~~) under section 103 of this act by
24 a successor who resides within the boundaries of the congressional
25 district from which the member whose office was vacated was elected as
26 they existed at the time of his or her election. At the election
27 immediately preceding expiration of the term of office of each board
28 member provided for in this subsection following the creation of either
29 new or new and additional congressional districts, and thereafter, a
30 successor shall be elected from the congressional district
31 (~~which~~) that corresponds in number with the congressional district
32 from which the incumbent was appointed or elected.

33 (~~(3) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section or~~
34 ~~chapter, in order to reduce the number of state board of education~~
35 ~~members elected from each congressional district from two members to~~
36 ~~one member the following transitional measures shall govern board~~
37 ~~member terms, elections, and voting:~~

1 ~~(a) The terms of office for each of the sixteen state board of~~
2 ~~education members and positions representing the first through the~~
3 ~~eighth congressional districts shall terminate in a sequence commencing~~
4 ~~with the terms of the four members and positions representing the third~~
5 ~~and sixth congressional districts as of the second Monday of January~~
6 ~~1993, followed by the terms of the six members and positions~~
7 ~~representing the first, fourth, and seventh congressional districts as~~
8 ~~of the second Monday of January 1994, and ending with the termination~~
9 ~~of the terms of the six members and positions representing the second,~~
10 ~~fifth, and eighth congressional districts as of the second Monday of~~
11 ~~January 1995;~~

12 ~~(b) An election shall be conducted under RCW 28A.305.040 through~~
13 ~~28A.305.060 each year preceding the termination of one or more terms~~
14 ~~under (a) of this subsection for the purpose of electing one state~~
15 ~~board of education member from each correspondingly numbered~~
16 ~~congressional district for a term of four years;~~

17 ~~(c) If for any reason a vacancy occurs in one of two positions~~
18 ~~representing a congressional district before the termination of the~~
19 ~~term for the position under (a) of this subsection, no replacement may~~
20 ~~be appointed or elected and the position shall be deemed eliminated;~~
21 ~~and~~

22 ~~(d) During the transition period from the second Monday of January~~
23 ~~1993, to the second Monday of January 1995, a vote on any matter before~~
24 ~~the state board of education by any one of two members representing the~~
25 ~~same congressional district shall be equal to one-half [of] a vote and~~
26 ~~a vote by any other member shall be equal to one full vote.~~
27 ~~Thereafter, the vote of each member shall be equal to one full vote.))~~

28 **Sec. 103.** RCW 28A.305.090 and 1990 c 33 s 264 are each amended to
29 read as follows:

30 Whenever there shall be a vacancy upon the state board of
31 education, from any cause whatever, it shall be the duty of the
32 remaining members of the board to fill such vacancy by appointment, and
33 the person so appointed shall continue in office until his or her
34 successor has been ((specially)) elected((, as hereinafter in this
35 section provided,))and has qualified. ((Whenever a vacancy occurs,
36 the superintendent of public instruction shall call, in the month of
37 August))At the next general election following the date of the
38 occurrence of ((such))the vacancy, ((a special election to be held in

1 ~~the same manner as other elections provided for in this chapter, at~~
2 ~~which election~~) a successor shall be elected to hold office for the
3 unexpired term of the member whose office was vacated.

4 NEW SECTION. Sec. 104. A new section is added to chapter 28A.305
5 RCW to read as follows:

6 An election shall be held at the general election after the
7 effective date of this section to elect members to the state board of
8 education. Members shall take office on the second Monday of January
9 following the election, on which date the terms of all members of the
10 state board of education holding office on the effective date of this
11 section shall expire. Of the initial members elected under this
12 section, members elected from even-numbered congressional districts
13 shall serve four-year terms and members elected from odd-numbered
14 congressional districts shall serve two-year terms. Newly elected
15 members of the state board of education shall serve until their
16 successors are elected and qualified. Members who are elected
17 subsequently shall be elected to four-year terms of office and shall
18 serve until their successors are elected and qualified and assume
19 office in accordance with RCW 29A.20.040.
