**Background:** In 2005, the Legislature created a crab pot buoy tag program in order to regulate the fishery and to keep track of harvest. The buoy tags allow for a more orderly fishery. Recent management agreements with other states require clarification in the buoy tag program to ensure out-of-state fishers are covered by Washington's requirements.

**Summary of Bill:** Out-of-state fishers are required to purchase and use buoy tags.

**Appropriation:** None.

**Fiscal Note:** Requested on January 16, 2006.

**Effective Date:** Ninety days after adjournment of session in which bill is passed.
