AN ACT Relating to protecting dependent persons by changing the crimes of criminal mistreatment and abandonment of a dependent person; amending RCW 9A.42.020, 9A.42.030, 9A.42.035, 9A.42.037, 9A.42.060, 9A.42.070, and 9A.42.080; reenacting and amending RCW 9.94A.515; prescribing penalties; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

- 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 8 **Sec. 1.** RCW 9A.42.020 and 1997 c 392 s 510 are each amended to 9 read as follows:
- 10 (1) A parent of a child, the person entrusted with the physical custody of a child or dependent person, a person who has assumed the 11 responsibility to provide to a dependent person the basic necessities 12 13 of life, or a person employed to provide to the child or dependent person the basic necessities of life is guilty of criminal mistreatment 14 in the first degree if he or she recklessly, as defined in RCW 15 16 9A.08.010, causes great bodily harm to a child or dependent person by withholding any of the basic necessities of life. 17
- 18 (2) Criminal mistreatment in the first degree is a class B felony.
