- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- NEW SECTION. Sec. 1. The legislature finds that the hydraulic 4 5 project approval provides critical protections for fish and fish habitat and is a key component of the state's approach to salmon 6 The legislature also finds that the hydraulic project 7 recovery. 8 approval is the only state permit solely intended to protect fish life. The legislature further finds that the hydraulic project approval 9 10 program needs to be redesigned to provide better customer service, 11 improved consistency, and enhanced compliance and effectiveness 12 monitoring. Therefore, it is the intent of the legislature to clarify the department of fish and wildlife's authority under chapter 77.55 13 RCW, streamline the application process to provide consistency and 14 15 predictability for permit applicants, and ensure that those hydraulic 16 projects with the highest potential risk to fish and fish habitat receive the highest priority. 17
