- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 29A.72.100 and 2003 c 111 s 1811 are each amended to read as follows:
 - upon single sheets of paper of good writing quality (including but not limited to newsprint) not less than ((eleven)) eight and one-half inches in width and not less than ((fourteen)) eleven inches in length. Each petition at the time of circulating, signing, and filing with the
