- 1 AN ACT Relating to the governor's signature on significant
- 2 legislative rules; and amending RCW 34.05.360.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF WASHINGTON:
- 4 **Sec. 1.** RCW 34.05.360 and 1988 c 288 s 311 are each amended to read as follows:
- The order of adoption by which each rule is adopted by an agency shall contain all of the following:
 - (1) The date the agency adopted the rule;
- 9 (2) A concise statement of the purpose of the rule;
- 10 (3) A reference to all rules repealed, amended, or suspended by the rule;
- 12 (4) A reference to the specific statutory or other authority 13 authorizing adoption of the rule;
- 14 (5) Any findings required by any provision of law as a precondition 15 to adoption or effectiveness of the rule; ((and))
- 16 (6) <u>If the rule qualifies as a significant legislative rule of an</u>
- 17 agency whose head or governing body is appointed by the governor, the
- 18 signature of the governor; and
